



TERMS OF USE AGREEMENT

Welcome to www.aac.ca (the "Website"), owned and operated by The Alberta Student Assessment Network, operating as the Alberta Assessment Consortium ("AAC"). By accessing and using the Website, you are agreeing to comply with and be bound by the Terms of Use in this Agreement (the "Agreement"). Please read the following Agreement carefully. If you do not wish to be bound by these terms and conditions, you may not access or use the Website. AAC may modify this agreement at any time, and such modifications shall be effective immediately upon posting of the modified agreement on the site.
